

Arbitration Place's arbitrators and mediators are independent of each other.

Most practice as sole practitioners, however, some also practice law at or have other connections with law firms, and some have other professional affiliations, including with other 'arbitration chambers'.

They do not, by virtue of being on our roster, have access to one another's files or electronic data, share confidences, or share their income with each other or Arbitration Place. None has any financial interest in Arbitration Place nor any affiliate. Each pays a fee to Arbitration Place to contribute to our marketing and other expenses, and those who have offices at Arbitration Place also pay Arbitration Place for their space. Arbitration Place provides various support services to arbitrators and mediators, for which they pay Arbitration Place.

In most cases, their bio on (or linked to) our website show, among other things, public professional and sometimes other affiliations (but not necessarily all affiliations).

From time to time, one or more of them may be engaged by a law or other professional firm, government or public body, corporation, third party funder, other organization or otherwise on a one-off, occasional or other basis, whether for legal or strategic advice, mock proceedings or otherwise.

They are not, by virtue of being on our roster, able to check for conflicts in relation to anyone else on the roster, nor in relation to the firms or other organizations with which others may be affiliated.

During the pendency of any arbitration or mediation, the affiliations of one or more may change, and others may join Arbitration Place's roster.

All potentially relevant aspects concerning any possible conflict, or any possible lack of independence or impartiality, should be raised directly with the arbitrator or mediator.
